## What's Happening



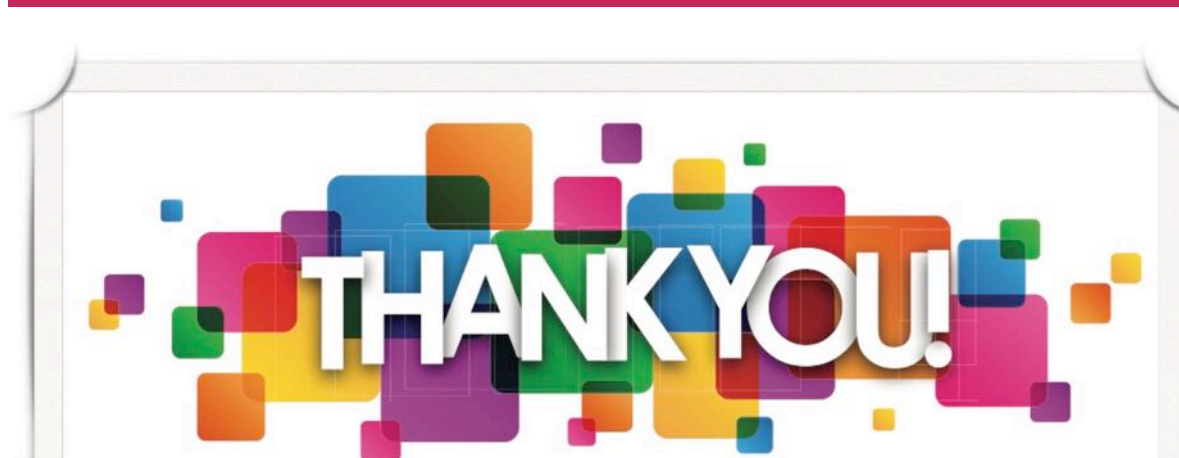
#### Lots happening with the following plans afoot:

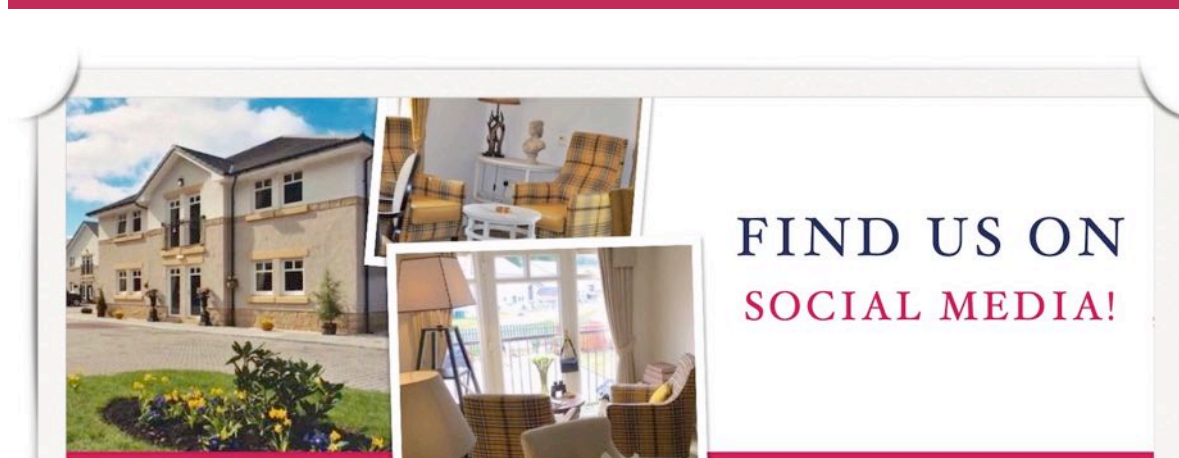
